Ephesians 4:30-32 (NASB)

³⁰And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. ³¹Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. ³²And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

• The Command = Walk in Love! (vs. 1-4)

How?

1. **Positively** – Be giving, caring, sacrificial, and unselfish toward others.

¹Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; ²and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you, and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

Ephesians 5:1-2 (NASB)

2. **Negatively** – Refuse to take, exploit, cheapen, defraud, or substitute sexual activity for genuine love and authentic intimacy.

```
<sup>3</sup>But do not let <u>immorality</u>
or <u>any impurity</u>
or <u>greed</u> even be named among you,
as is proper among saints;
```

⁴and <u>no filthiness,</u>

<u>silly talk,</u>

<u>coarse jesting,</u> which are not fitting,
but rather giving of thanks.

Love & Sex: Knowing the Difference Makes All the Difference (Eph. 5:3-6)

• <u>The Reason</u> = Sexual Impurity Destroys Relationships

```
<sup>5</sup>For this you know with certainty, that
no <u>immoral</u>
or <u>impure person</u>
or <u>covetous man</u>, (who is an idolater),
has an inheritance in the kingdom
of Christ and God.
```

⁶Let no one <u>deceive</u> you with empty words,

for because of <u>these things</u> (mentioned above) the <u>wrath of God comes upon</u> the sons of disobedience.
